New for 2024! All sheep will be vet checked at the Festival before being unloaded to be penned in the barn displays or involved in the youth show. The vet will be on the grounds all day Friday and Saturday morning.

**New Hampshire Sheep** must have permanent identification. All sheep must originate from a non-quarantined flock and animals must not have been exposed to scrapie, scabies or any other contagious or infectious disease, and shall not be the direct progeny (first generation) of any animal diagnosed as having scrapie. Sheep must have a Scrapie's tag in its ear.

**Out of State Sheep** must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and permanent identification. All sheep must originate from an inspected, non-quarantined flock; the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection shall state that the animals have not been exposed to scrapie, scabies or any other contagious or infectious disease; and the animal shall not be the progeny of a sire or dam that was infected with scrapie. Sheep must have a Scrapies tag in its ear.

#### LEADLINE CLASS

Open to all sheep.

This competition is a sheep and wool promotional class.

Each youth is judged on how well they exemplify the sewing and wearing of wool, along with interest and support of a sheep project.

1. Members who chose to enter the Lead Line class must write a narrative. 2. The member must wear a garment, self-made or purchased, with the composition of the fiber being at least 70% wool. 3. The member's garment may be knit, crocheted, sewn, woven or felted. Jeans may not be part of the outfit and cannot be worn in the show ring.
4. The member must show their owned or leased animal, and the animal must have been shown in a breed or market class.
5. No decorating of the sheep is allowed.

#### SHEEP COSTUME CLASS

**Competition:** Judging is based on attractiveness, originality and theme/idea presented by the exhibitor

**Objective:** Promote lamb and wool in a fun, creative way. This class is meant to be light-hearted and fun.

Please prepare a narrative about the costume and your sheep that can be read while you are in the show ring.
